RITA'S STORY

Hello, my name is Rita. I grew up the middle of nine children, working in the farm fields of Wisconsin. I was also a straight A student, well, almost. I became a computer programmer and work in IT. I am a smart person who was living in a cancer-free bubble. No one I knew had any experience with cancer, not my brothers and sisters, friends, no one.

In June 2012, my smart, cancer-free bubble burst. When they told me I had cancer, it was as if a water balloon had burst open. Everything I knew flowed out of me or seemed useless. I was overwhelmed by my ignorance. I didn't know anything about facing cancer nor did I have anyone in my life I could ask. I was so overwhelmed, I couldn't even think of a question to ask.

Upon diagnosis, Gilda's Club Madison was one of my first stops. I walked through Gilda's red doors and there was a library right in front of me. I grabbed some books, sat in a comfy chair, and began learning. I went to support groups, informational sessions, yoga, Zumba and finally, a Transitions class. They were there for me and helped at every stage. **Gilda's Club Madison helped me figure out not only the answers, but also what questions to ask.** I am here today, surviving the bubble bursting and the tidal wave of ignorance. Fifteen months of primary treatment and I'm still learning with the help of the people at Gilda's Club Madison.

When I was first diagnosed with stage four ovarian and uterine cancer, I went looking for a Gilda's Club for knowledge and support. It was then I had the first of two misconceptions most have about Gilda's Club debunked. I assumed there were Gilda's Clubs everywhere and there aren't. I also learned there wasn't one in Madison at the time so I found support through the hospital and other means. However, I vowed that if I beat my cancer, I would help bring a Gilda's Club to Madison.

I was lucky and am here today because of a great team of doctors and the support of many friends and family members. But because Gilda's is a resource not just for patients but friends and family, it would have been a lot easier for everyone had this place existed then. And that was the second misconception. Like many, I thought Gilda's Club was only for women with certain types of cancer. It's not. It's a comfortable environment where anyone who is affected by cancer – men, women, children, family and friends – can come as they are, both physically and emotionally.

I know Gilda's Club does a lot of good helping people live with cancer and I've seen the studies that show this kind of emotional support can help improve treatment outcomes. That's why I made a place for Gilda's Club in my will and encourage others to do the same. **A legacy gift will ensure this wonderful place and the people who make it special will be around for generations to come.**

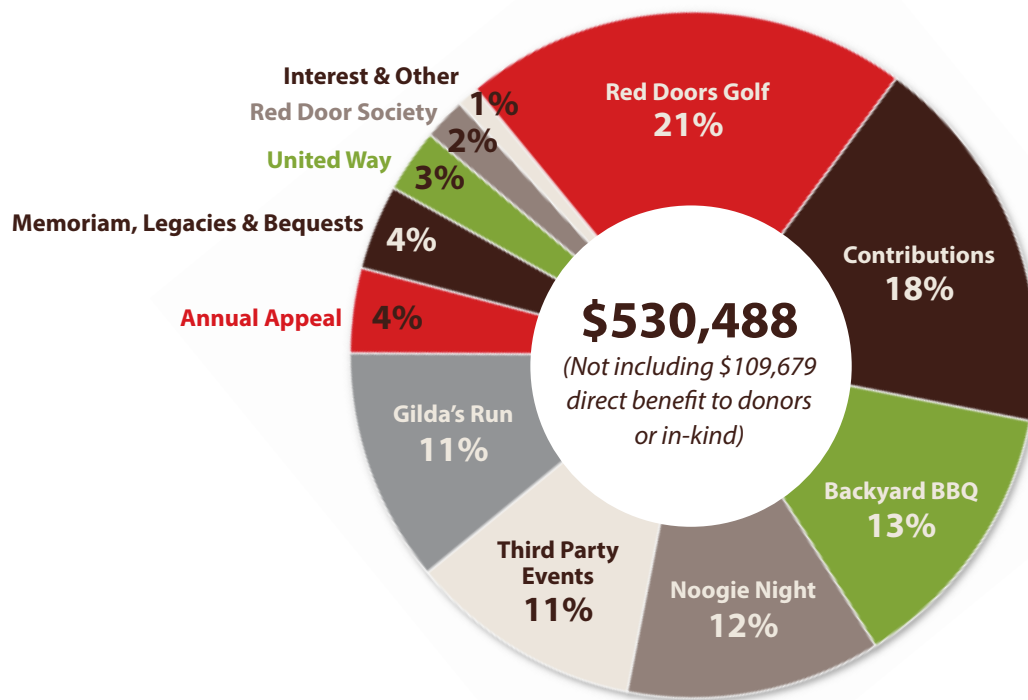

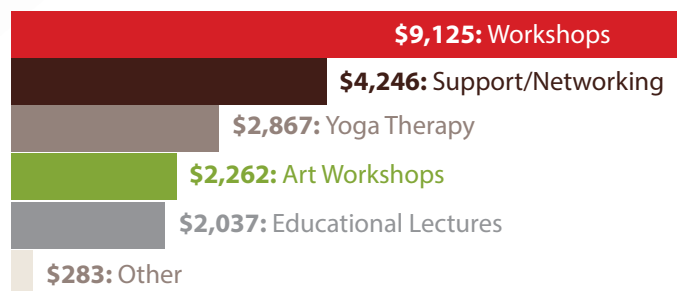
